

EXHIBITOR POLICY

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to assure that only authorized exhibitors and Lions projects be permitted to display and sell their services at State Council Meetings or the MD 14 State Convention.

GENERAL:

1. All exhibitors and Lions projects must have permission of the Council of Governors prior to selling or displaying items at any State Council Meeting or MD 14 State Convention as outlined in the Exhibitors and Lions Projects Rules and Regulations.
2. Selling of chances, raffle tickets, merchandise items and commercial displays is not permitted by any sub-district, local Lions, Lioness or Leo Clubs at any State Council Meeting or MD 14 State Convention.

The sub-district hosting the State Council Meeting or MD 14 State Convention the following year may sell chances, raffle tickets or merchandise to defray the cost of the event.

3. No merchandise may be sold that is available through the Pennsylvania State Lions Supply Store.
4. A fee will be assessed to the exhibitors at a cost of \$_____ with a minimum charge of \$ 300.00. The Host Committee shall present the proposed fees at the first State Council Meeting for approval. All revenues received from the exhibitors are considered administrative income and shall be reported on policy 201C.
 - a. The MD 14 State Convention Host District Chairman shall present all exhibitors and Lions projects to State Council for their approval at the third State Council Meeting.
 - b. No Exhibitor or Lions Projects will be accepted after the close of the third State Council Meeting.
 - c. All commercial exhibitors are required to provide a certificate of insurance along with their exhibitor's application.
5. The Pennsylvania Lions Sight Conservation and Eye Research and Diabetes Foundation, Pennsylvania Lions Hearing Foundation, Pennsylvania Lions Foundation, Pennsylvania Lions Beacon Lodge Camp, Leader Dogs for the Blind, The Pride magazine and the next year's State Convention Host Committee shall be charged a minimal fee, determined by the Host Committee, to cover the charges or setting up the display area.
6. The following Lions projects: Pennsylvania Eye Banks, Guide Dog Schools (except Leader Dogs for the Blind), local district or Lions clubs supported agencies or projects and pin traders, may display their activity or projects at the MD 14 State Convention when there is available space in the display area on a first-come first-serve basis. There will be a fee of \$100.00 for the display.

7. All exhibitors and Lion projects must follow all the Rules and Regulations as outlined in a separate agreement.
